Every patient has a personal bedside tablet screen and all you'll need at home is a laptop, tablet or mobile and of course wifi!

- **Make a Skype call direct to their bedside - www.skype.com**
 - Log into your account or create an account
 - Type in your loved one's username or email address and the call will connect
 - Hospice staff can assist your loved one to make and receive calls
- **If you're all Apple users you can do group FaceTime calls to their iPhone or iPad**
- **Get the whole family on WhatsApp group calls to their mobile phone**

 - Free for calls up to 40 minutes for up to 100 participants
